

# TONSIL AND ADENOID DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS Page 1 of 2

## **FOLLOW UP CARE**

- Severe sore throat is common, do not expect to be pain free
- Ear pain is normal and should resolve in 2 weeks
- Bad breath can last for 1-2 weeks
- Tongue pain and changes in taste should resolve in 2 weeks
- Foreign body sensation in the throat when swallowing is common
- Blood tinged saliva the day of surgery is common
- Drooling may occur for 1-2 weeks
- A follow up appointment is not usually made for tonsil surgery, if you feel you need to see your doctor, please call the office to make an appointment

### WHAT TO DO FOR BLEEDING

 Bright red blood from the mouth or nose can occur for up to 2 weeks. Gargle with ice cold water for 10 minutes, if this does not stop the bleeding or if bleeding is severe, call your doctor immediately

### **ACTIVITY**

- Do not drive for 24 hours
- No heavy lifting or strenuous activity for 2 weeks
- · Smoking impairs healing and should be avoided

### DIET

Resume previous diet as tolerated
